LaQshya-Manyata is a joint initiative between the National Health Mission, Government of Maharashtra and The Federation of Obstetric and Gynaecological Societies of India (FOGSI), aimed at improving quality of private maternity care in the state of Maharashtra by building skilled and capable teams ensuring consistent, safe and respectful care for mothers during and after childbirth. The 26 standards defined under the initiative are in line with the national government's LaQshya program and World Health Organization (WHO) standard guidelines.

How can LaQshya - Manyata benefit you?

01 Training and Capacity Building

1. Comprehensive training on 16 Clinical and 10 Facility Standards assures adherence to basic clinical practices that results in delivering High Quality Care to patients
2. Flexible training sessions, simplified standards and 1:1 on-site mentoring approach together provide a streamlined quality improvement model - designed to meet private providers' diverse needs. Trainings reinforce team approach to childbirth and the staff is better prepared at handling complications and referrals

02 Financial Model

1. Quality services attract more patients and build loyalty leading to more lucrative business

LAQSHYA-MANYATA CLINICAL STANDARDS

- 01 Screens for key clinical conditions that may lead to complications during pregnancy.
(To be verified only among booked cases)
- 02 Prepares for safe care during delivery (to be checked every day)
- 03 Assesses all pregnant women at admission
- 04 Conducts PV examination appropriately and follow infection prevention
- 05 Monitors the progress of labor appropriately
- 06 Ensures respectful and supportive care
- 07 Assists the woman to have a safe and clean birth
- 08 Conducts a rapid initial assessment and performs immediate newborn care (if baby cries immediately)
- 09 Performs Active Management of Third Stage of Labor (AMTSL)
- 10 Identifies and manages Post-Partum Hemorrhage (PPH)
- 11 Identifies and manages severe Pre-eclampsia/Eclampsia (PE/E)
- 12 Performs newborn resuscitation if baby does not cry immediately after birth
- 13 Ensures care of newborn with small size at birth
- 14 Ensures the facility adhere to universal infection prevention protocols
- 15 Ensures adequate postpartum care package is offered to the mother and baby, at discharge
- 16 Provider reviews clinical practices related to C-section at regular intervals

LAQSHYA-MANYATA FACILITY STANDARDS

- 01 Provides curative & RMNCH services such as functional labour room/ OT, family planning counselling, functional newborn resuscitation and referral services. In addition, the facility has equipments ready for normal/assisted/caesarean section and laboratory services.
- 02 Has safe secure infrastructure for delivery of assured services, as per the prevalent norms.
- 03 Provides patient friendly environment and undertakes patient/attendant/community education activities.
- 04 Has equipment & instruments required for assured list of services and has program for maintenance and calibration of equipment.
- 05 Defines procedures for storage, inventory management and dispensing of drugs and procedures for safe drug administration.
- 06 Establishes procedures for patient identification, nursing care, and informing patients about medical condition and treatment.
- 07 Maintains and update patients clinical records.
- 08 Adequately staffed with trained manpower and conducts continuous capacity building trainings for maintaining quality services at the facility.
- 09 Improves quality as well as measures clinical care & safety, basis patient feedback. In doing so, the facility reviews service quality indicators, ensuring quality assurance through internal assessments and audits.
- 10 Defines procedures for preoperative assessment, preparation and monitoring of the patients during surgery and anesthesia.
